September 2022 Chosen Charity: *The Angel Project Canada*

- Many patients spend decades in Complex Care units in hospitals and will never go home again; accident victims, MS, ALS patients and others who have been left without tools and the finances to fend for themselves and have been abandoned by their families and society
- Assist with the purchase of items such as wheelchairs, voice boxes and speech computers, SMARTboards, chair lifts, breathing machines, treadmills, stroke walkers, exercise equipment and activity supplies
- Rebuilding lounges and spaces for patients, hospital outdoor gardens
- Personal Hygiene products, personalised gifts, handmade quilts, bingo cart with prizes, craft corner with supplies
- Outings for patients (hockey games, trips to mall, park or gardens, fairs, etc.) + medical transport
- Entertainment at the hospital (musicians, etc)

- April 2022 recipient received \$8,215 from 100WWCB
- Evangeline shared that our funds were used to support their programs:
 - 36 Mentor Relationships
 - 35 registered for Skill-Building & Corporate Wellness
 - Resulting in 107 Professionals being touched this year alone by our funds
- People feel empowered to reach their career goals
- Programs & Services remain free of charge

- Educate, engage & provide opportunities for action for young people, aged 14-24
- Many people have “climate anxiety”
- This charity provides a fun and engaging way to be directly involved in climate-change initiatives
- They partner with any groups/areas in Burlington to address needs: litter clean-up, waste sorting, invasive species removal, tree & garden planting, community gardens, etc.
- There is no dedicated funding to continue youth network at this time; 100WWCB support could fund them for 5 months

- This group encompasses all types of dementias
- Provides Dementia Education, Counselling & Support Services
- 282,000+ people are currently living with dementia in Ontario
- Caregiving hours are expected to continue to rise as ageing population increases with people living longer
- Disproportionally affects women because women tend to live longer
- Funds could assist music program *(which coincidentally was what our previous support helped them launch in 2015)*
